Unit 4: 169 day total grazing season with 4 *required* rotations

- 6 total water facilities
- 1.5 miles of temporary electric fencing required
- Approximately 2880 total acres

Unit 5: 169 day total grazing season with 6 *required* rotations

- 9 total water facilities
- 2 miles of temporary electric fencing required
- Approximately 3680 total acres

** Bulls are considered 1.5 AUE for invoicing purposes.*

Paddocks are subject to be Spring grazed prior to Summer in date.

Half payment due March 1st. Second payment due 30 days after latest out date.
